#### Homeowner's Dues

Homeowner's dues were mailed out the first week of April. Statements with open balances were sent out on May 1, 2014.

Homeowners that have not paid their dues by July 1, 2014 will be charged a \$15 late fee and 1% a month interest.

If unpaid after 90 days a lien will be placed on the home. If a lien is filed against the property, there will be a \$100 fee assessed. An additional \$24 filing fee will also be assessed to release the lien after full payment is made.

#### Birds and Butterflies

More than 50 species of birds have been seen in Carriage Oaks.

Feeders, water and birdhouses are ways to draw birds to your yard. Small fruits from flowering crabs, golden privet, etc. will attract birds in late winter when food is hard to come by and cold weather has made these fruits more palatable to some birds.

Butterfly bushes are great butterfly attracters and a relatively attractive bush.

The caterpillar stage of the blue butterfly eats parsley leaves.

#### Please & Thank You

- ✓ Please keep your mailbox in good repair. Many of our mailboxes are sagging, leaning, rusting or peeling. We all thank you for keeping up the appearance of our neighborhood.
- ✓ Please comply with the neighborhood streets speed limit of 25 mph. The children playing in the neighborhood thank you.
- ✓ Please do not park boats, trailers, campers, etc. on your driveway, yard, or on the street for longer than 48 hours. Your neighbors thank you.
- ✓ Please do not park vehicles across the sidewalk. The pedestrians, who have to walk into the street or on the lawn to get by, thank you.
- ✓ Please pick up after your dog. We are starting to see some droppings left behind again. Those that have stepped in it, thank you.
- ✓ Please keep your yard lights in good working condition. This is a safety concern and the whole neighborhood thanks you.
- ✓ Please prune trees to provide eight feet of clearance over the sidewalk and fourteen feet of clearance over the street. This is a city ordinance. The pedestrians ducking under the trees thank you.

My curb is deteriorating. Whose responsibility is that?

• This too is considered the property owner's responsibility.
